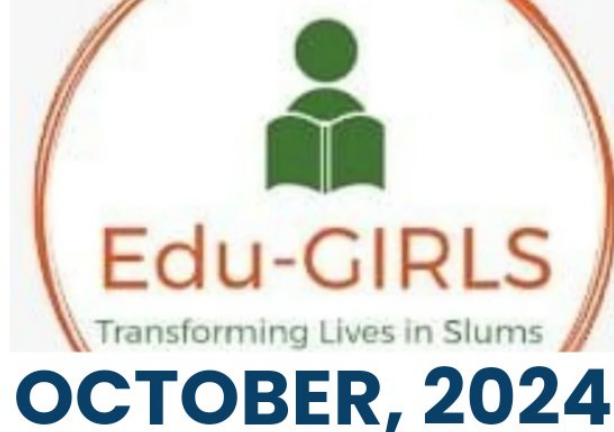

Gandhi Jayanti Celebration

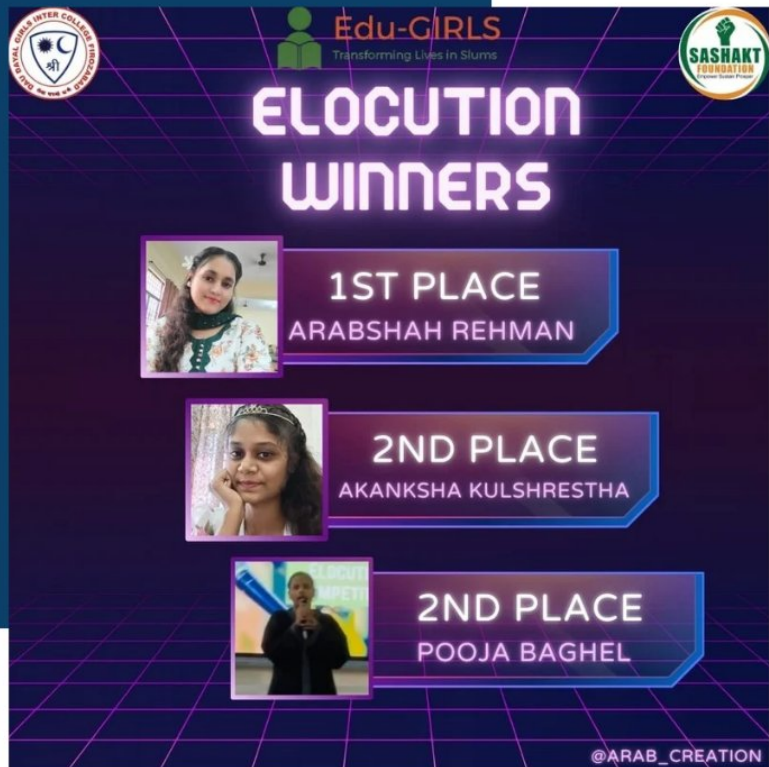

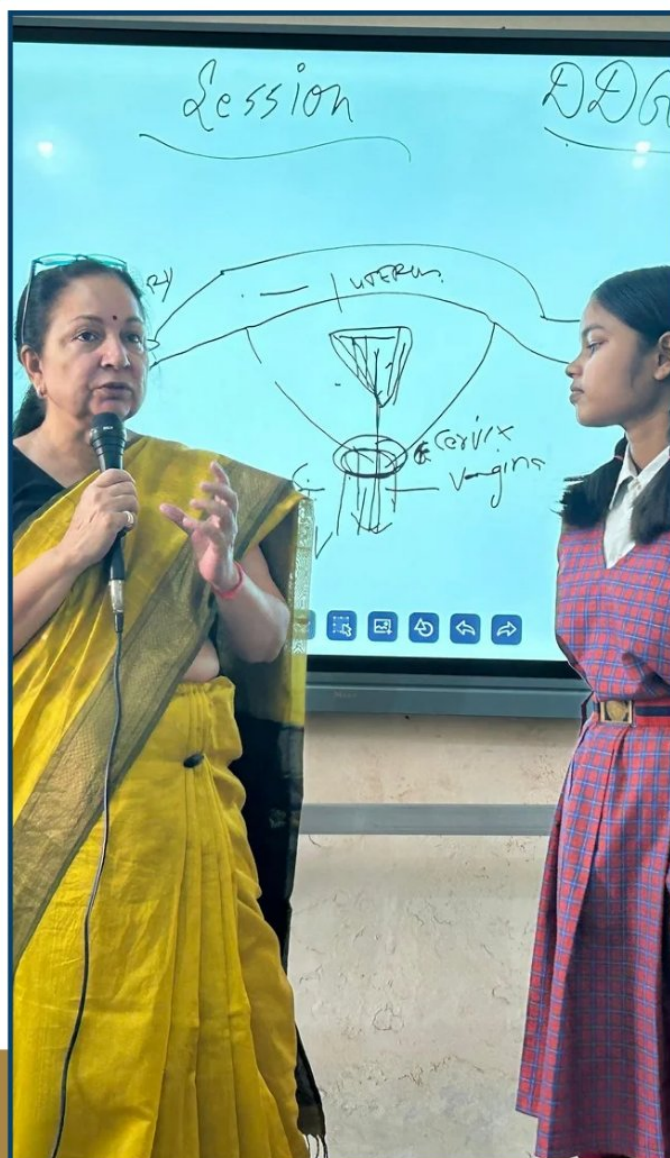


Confident Elocution Displayed

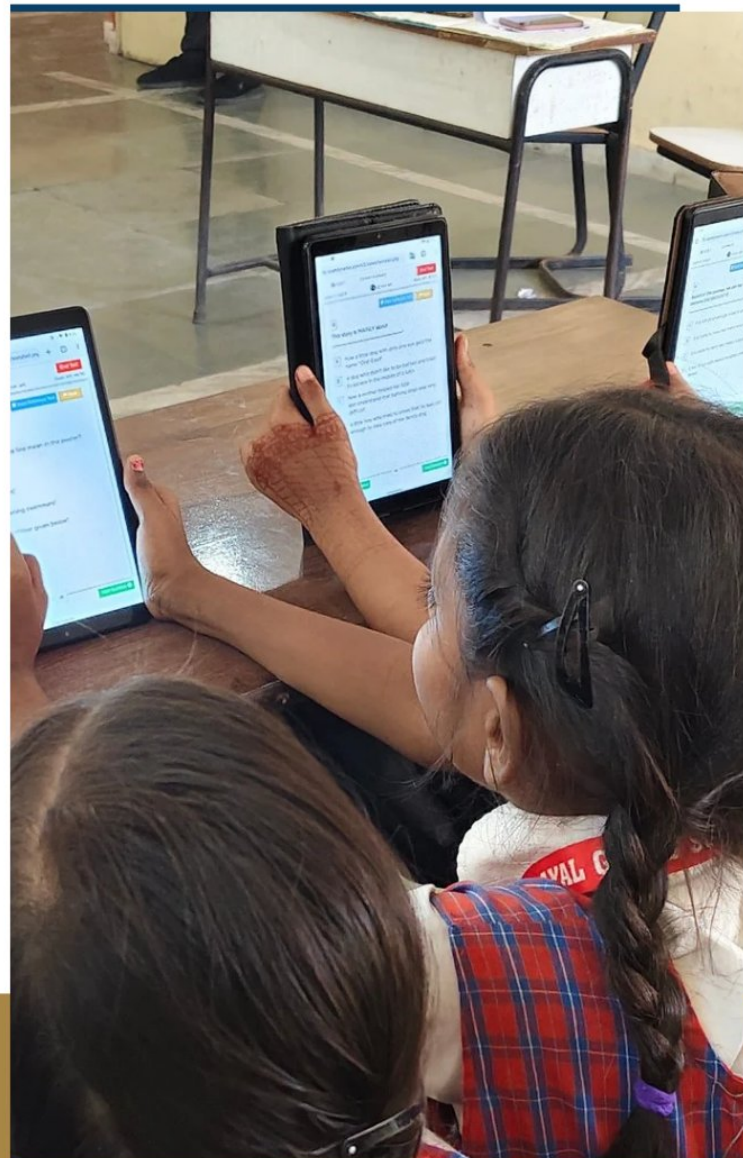


Teacher Talk Session
