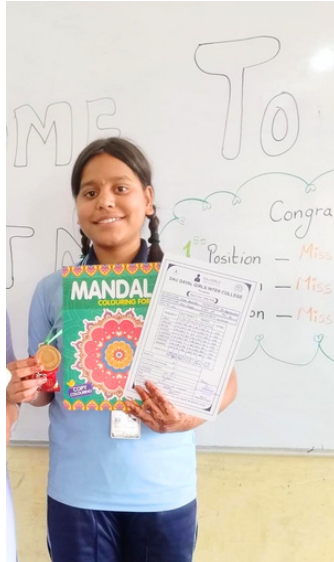
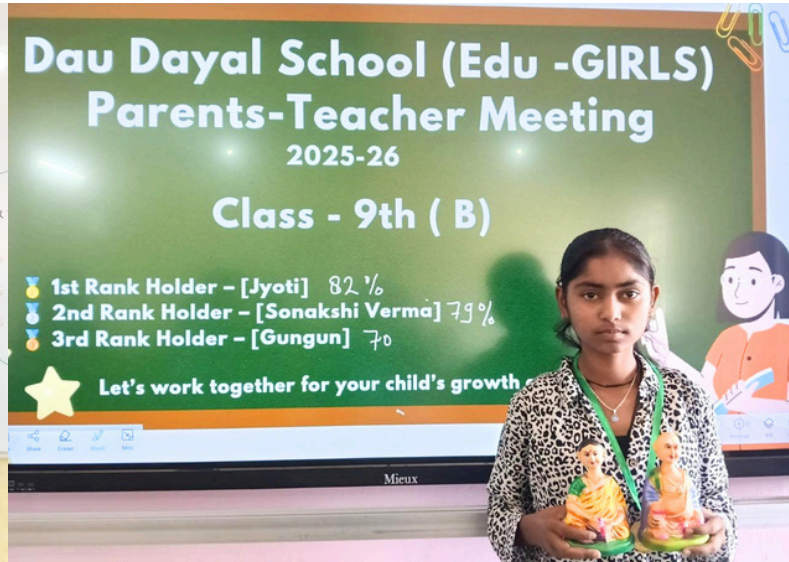

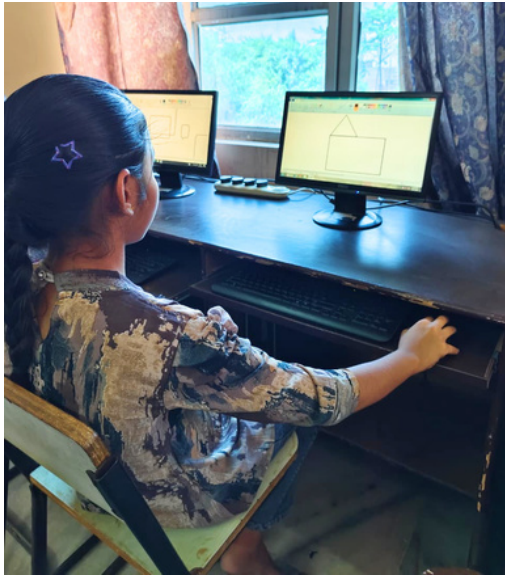
All our students passed with flying colors and were promoted to the next session.
